Grant Themes

Grants will be open in the following categories:

STEM and education

Creating learning and development opportunities. E.g. provision of resources for schools, educational programs or programs that provide access to education.

Environmental leadership

Programs that help the community to participate in renewable energy and reduce their carbon footprint as we decarbonise the grid. E.g. programs that improve or restore the local environment or programs that support local art and culture or community connections.

What happens next?

All grants will be assessed against a criteria that considers the:

- Community impact and reach
- Community benefit
- Ability of the project to encourage social change
- The financial robustness of the program.

The review process will be undertaken by Endeavour Energy specialists from across the business.

Shortlisted applicants will be reviewed by a third party to ensure legitimacy. All applicants will then be notified of the outcome of their application.



Community resilience

Programs that support the community to plan for, withstand and recover from extreme weather events or help the community to manage disruptive events.

E.g. Public emergency response kits or community resilience education programs.



Programs that support inclusiveness, equity and diversity, increase energy literacy or support the health and wellbeing of our community.

E.g. activities that support diverse communities or those experiencing vulnerable circumstances or programs that support cost of living pressures for customers.

Who can apply?

The grants program is open to incorporated not-for-profit organisations or registered charities, schools or community groups who have a valuable grassroots initiative that delivers clear benefits for the community in the areas of STEM and education, community resilience, environmental leadership and/or social inclusion. Applicants will need an Australian Business Number (ABN) or be registered with the Australian Charities and Not-for-profits Commission (ACNC).

What funding is available?

Endeavour Energy is offering grants of between \$2,000 and \$15,000. Grants funding must be intended solely for the proposed project, and projects cannot be funded retrospectively.

Endeavour Energy community grants program

How to apply

To be considered for a grant you must complete an application form through the Endeavour Energy website by 11.59pm, Sunday 20 October.

The application will require you to provide an overview of the proposed project and what it will enable including:


- Grant theme Indicate which theme/themes your project delivers against, and how it will deliver against this project theme
- Target beneficiaries Who/how many people will benefit from your program
- Community impact Describe the measurable outcomes of your program
- Project delivery Completion date and key milestones
- Funding information How much funding you are seeking. List any other funding partners and provide a high level break down of costs.

As part of the grant process you will be required to complete the reporting template and agree to the grants program Terms and Conditions.

Endeavour Energy network

To be eligible to apply for a grant, your project will need to directly benefit communities located within the Endeavour Energy network.

Your organisation / program may operate outside of our network with part of the program supporting communities within the Endeavour Energy network.
